## 台北

- 平溪十分老街 - 特色在于老建筑,火车门前过是十分老街全台北独特的街景.狭窄的街道,火车就从两排民宅的中间驶过.街道两侧有许多店家贩售天灯,在铁道上放天灯,形成老街,铁道,天灯相映成趣的画面。
- 九份山城 - 独特的旧式建筑,坡地以及风情,使九份成为台湾最受欢迎的观光景点之一。这里还可以品尝到草仔粿、蕃薯丸、芋头丸、潮州鱼丸等各式小吃。
- 士林夜市 - 是台北市大规模的观光夜市,因邻近学区拥有众多年轻族群客层,加上捷运站及公车交通便利而成为具有指标性的夜市。士林夜市拥有众多小吃美食,像是士林大香肠、蚵仔煎、臭豆腐、冰品及大饼包小饼等。

## 高雄

- 佛光山 - 台湾最大的佛教寺院和世界公认的佛教圣地。佛光山位于高雄县大树乡,在提倡「人间佛学」的开山大师星云睿智的领导下,历经数10年的开发与兴建,寺庙建筑宏伟壮观。
- 旗山老街 - 为高雄市旗山区,旧称番薯寮街,从糖厂火车站开始延伸。早期糖业带动当地的市街发展,以由石块堆砌而成的圆拱亭仔脚为主要特色。
- 春秋阁 - 有九曲桥相通,又称【春秋御阁】,系为纪念武圣关公而建。
- 龙虎塔 - 塔高七层,楼前各有龙虎塑像,游客可以身为道,由龙口进,虎口出,取其吉祥如意。

## 南投

- 泰雅度假村 - 泰雅度假村于民国76年开始动工新建,民国81年开幕营业。占地47公顷,在广阔的园区,将山林野趣,丰富的自然生态,加上温泉设施,规划成一个国际型渡假休闲温泉特区。而本园区里有丰富多样貌的动、植物、昆虫生态和泰雅族、赛德克族文化,再配合志工导览老师的专业解说、导览,将使本园在营运上有更大优势,能提供游客家庭渡假、学校校外教学旅游行程的规划上一个户外生态学习的优质园地。
- 日月潭风景区 - 闻名中外日月潭为台湾八景之一,日月潭以峻山碧水相辉映的环湖公路边的文武庙主祀关帝,另外加奉祀孔子与岳飞,庙内所有神像,皆用铜铸,建筑金碧辉煌,香火鼎盛。随之参观孔雀园饲养两百多只孔雀与名贵禽鸟。

## 台中

- 逢甲夜市 - 夜市的范围包括逢甲大学方圆一公里之内,是台中最具人气的商圈之一。商圈内贩卖种类繁多,应有尽有,衣食住行育乐全都包含,令人目不暇接,众多选择的小吃闻名遐迩。对喜欢shopping逛街、吃吃喝喝的民众来说这里真的是五星级的好地方啊!

## TAIPEI

- **Shihfen Old Street** - Although the Shihfen Old Street does not necessarily attract tourists due to its traditional architecture, it does boast the unique attribute of serving as the only old street in Taiwan, which trains pass through on a daily basis. As they happily enjoy delicious home-cooked noodles, visitors can enjoy the sight of trains passing along the unfenced railway gates.
- **Chiufen** - A place where you get a chance to taste the local snacks and foods of Taiwan such as Taro and Sweet Potato Ball etc.
- **Shihlin Night Market** - Considered to be the largest and most famous night market in the city. Great place of local handicrafts, clothes, toys, tasty local snacks and souvenirs.

## KAOHSIUNG

- **Fo Guang Shan** - You will see a 120-metre golden Buddha Amitabha statue with 480 standing Buddha statues, surrounded by flowing water and lush foliage
- **Qi Shan Old Street** - For the area in Kaohsiung Qi Shan, Liu Street formerly known as sweet potato, sugar from the train station extends Qi Shan. Sugar led the early development of local streets to a pile of stones made by the Aberdeen Pavilion arched foot for the main features.
- **Spring And Autumn Pavilions & Dragon Tiger Tower** - Where you be amused by gigantic statues of Dragon and Tiger Pagodas & Hsun Tien Shangti Temple.

## NANTOU

- **Atayal Resort** - Atayal Resort started constructing in 1987 and operating in 1992. It has an area of 47 hectors as an international spring resort with wild amusement, abundant nature ecology, and spring facilities. People pay more attention to environmental protection. The Resort has diverse animal, plant, and insect ecological system and Atayal and Seedy cultures. With the professional tour and explanation by the volunteers, the Resort has its advantages in operating to provide an excellent place for family vacation and school field trips.
- **Sun Moon Lake** - is Taiwan's largest freshwater lake, located in a basin surrounded by peaks. Its beauty has given rise to such names as "Pearl in the Mountains," "Honeymoon Lake," and "Lovers' Lake." It has also been called the "Heart of Taiwan," not for romantic reasons, but for its role as a major hydropower generator.
- **Wenwu Temple** - This monumental temple, built in China's Northern Dynasty style and is a famous temple that sits on the surrounding Sun Moon Lake which is one of the popular tourist destinations in Taiwan.
