观光景点:







东京

- **皇居** 是指日本天皇居住的宫殿。传统上,日本没有定都的概念,习惯以在位天皇的所在地为国都,并以在位天皇居住之宫殿为皇居。现在的皇居位于东京都千代田区,即原江户幕府历代将军所居住的江户城。
- 银座 与巴黎的香榭丽舍大街、纽约的第五大街齐名,是世界三大繁华中心之一。银座 是许多百年老铺与本土品牌的发祥地,它是日本高级、名牌、流行、品味、信用、货真 价实、憧憬、时尚的代名词。

横滨

- **横滨中华街** 日本横滨中华街至今已有140余年历史。具有140年历史的华人居住区,属于日本最大的唐人街。
- 新横滨拉面博物馆 是全球首家饮食娱乐园,建于1994。日本将拉面定位为乡土料理,出于无需乘坐飞机便可遍遍尝日本全国各地名店风味这一构想,创建了拉面博物馆。

富士

- 富士西湖合掌村 位于富士山脚下、西湖根场所在地是古时日本居民聚居的地方,不过由于城市急速发展,居民都迁出市区,开发商就萌生了把昔日乡村样貌还原的意念,建成了现在的西湖里根场合掌村。多栋屋舍用特殊的稻草编织起层层屋顶,特别是两边的屋顶像是一本打开的书一样、成一个三角形状。在每栋建筑物中,除了有传统工艺的体验外,还有资料馆、美食馆等可以游览参观。
- **富士山五合目** 富士山从山脚到山顶,共划分为10个阶段,每个阶段是一个"合目",由山脚下出发到半山腰称为五合目,由五合目再往上攀登,便是六合目、七合目,直至山顶的十合目。每合目都设有供游人休息的地方,巴士最高可上到2305米的五合目。
- **忍野八海** 忍野八海是位于山梨县山中湖和河口湖之间忍野村的涌泉群。忍野八海历史悠长,据说在1200年前就有了,八海意为八个池塘,是忍野地区指定的国家自然风景区,1985年入选"日本名水百选",还有日本九寨沟的美誉。它源于富士山顶的积雪,当积雪溶化成水渗入地底,经过地底的熔岩石过滤、沉积了八十多年才终于流进忍野八海,因此泉水相当清澈且含有大量矿物质。

千叶

小江户川越 - 川越节被指定为国家重要无形民俗文化财产,其延续着江户时代的祭典,保留着江户文化和气息的历史名城。在飘荡着江户古老气息的空间,体验川越那多姿多彩的活动和购物。

Tokyo

- Imperial Palace Is the primary residence of the Emperor of Japan. It is a large park-like
 area located in the Chiyoda ward of Tokyo and contains buildings including the main palace,
 the private residences of the Imperial Family, an archive, museums and administrative
 offices.
- Ginza Is Tokyo's most famous up market shopping, featuring numerous department stores, boutiques, art galleries, restaurants and cafes. Also one of the most expensive, upscale areas in Tokyo which is jewelled with upscale retail like as Louis Vuitton, Chanel, Hermes, De Beers, Tiffany and Apple.

Yokohama

- Yokohama Chinatown Yokohama Chinatown is known as the world's best Chinese food spot. With more than 600 shops, there are plenty of restaurants to choose from.
- Shin-Yokohama Raumen Museum It was founded on March 6th, 1994 as the world's first food-themed amusement park. From the start, our concept has been to be the one-stop place to enjoy the flavors of this national dish from renowned shops across Japan without stepping on a plane.

Fuii

- Saiko Iyashi Sato Nenba Iyashi no Sato stands on the site of a former farming village on the western shores of Lake Saiko. Village is surrounded by Aokigahara Forest. Also, during a sunny day, from Iyashi no Sato you can see the top of Mt. Fuji. Walking around the Iyashi no Sato makes you feel like time turned back to the Showa period. It's really worth seeing!
- Mount Fuji Mt. Fuji, rising above the clouds, is the symbol of Japan and has provided a spiritual basis for the Japanese since ancient times. This 3776 meters high, dormant volcano is world renowned for its symmetry and serenity.
- Oshino Hakkai Oshino Hakkai is a touristy set of eight ponds in Oshino, a small village in the Fuji Five Lake region. The eight ponds are fed by snow melt from the slopes of nearby Mount Fuji that filters down the mountain through porous layers of lava for over 80 years, resulting in very clear spring water that is revered by the locals.

Chiba

• Koedo-Kawagoe - The old storehouse merchant houses are lined up, and the Toki-no-kane (Bell Tower) rings to tell the time. Take a stroll through the town in a kimono and you'll feel as if you've travelled back in time to ancient Edo. In Kawagoe, you can experience the traditional and pure Japan which you can't see in Tokyo.
